Did you know that 1 in 3 Americans will be diagnosed with cancer in their lifetime?

What is Relay? Relay for Life is the ACS's signature event to raise awareness and funding to fight cancer. Teams of people camp out at a local high school, park, or fairground and take turns walking or running around a track or path. Relays are overnight events, up to 24 hours in length. Each team is asked to have a representative on the track at all times during the event because cancer never sleeps.

Why Relay? The American Cancer Society Relay for Life gives everyone the opportunity to fight back and to make a difference in the battle against cancer. Teams can be formed from businesses, clubs, families, friends, hospitals, faith-based groups, schools and service organizations.

This year, 32 Relay's will take place in the greater metro Indianapolis area alone and St. Francis Cancer Center—Mooresville is a proud sponsor of this year's Relay for Life in Mooresville, IN.
